Regularly meet your assigned mentor.

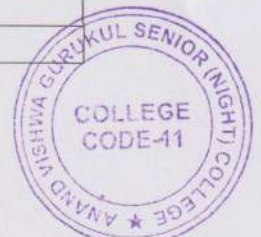
Share your academic progress and challenges.

#### 2.6.3 Pass percentage of students during the year

Following is the list of result declared for 5 under graduate programmes in academic year 2023-24. The final year last semester result of the all program of academic year 2324 are as follows:

#### Under Graduate Programmes:

TYBCOM (Commerce)-95students appeared and 50 students passed the final exam. With a passing percentage of 52.63%.

#### Self-financing Section (UG):

TYBMS (Management Studies)-60 student appeared and 33 students passed the final exam. With a passing percentage of 55.00%

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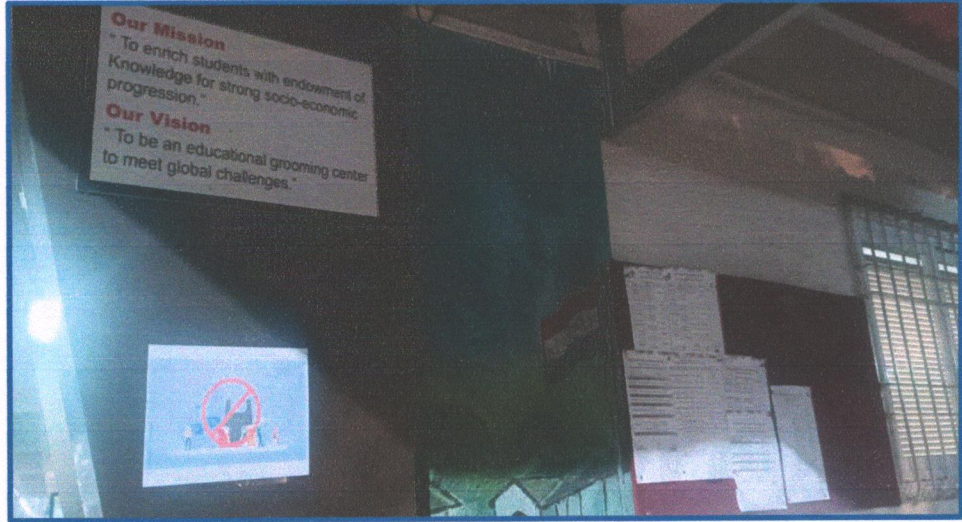
