- c. Mutual Co-Operation between IQAC's of both Institutes.
- d. The Parties acknowledge the value of collaborative research and academic supervision and agree to promote co-guideship arrangements for students pursuing research projects or academic endeavors.
- e. If any of the faculty of both the institutes wishes to opt as a co-guide, either of the institute should provide the consent or cooperate the faculty and students.

3. PROPOSED MODES OF COLLABORATION:

- d) To give preference to staff and student participants of either institutes.
- e) This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Institutes at any time.
- f) Either Institute shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other Institute.
- g) On mutual consent of both the Institutes, review meetings will be conducted once in three months with Co-ordinator's and Principals.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY:



The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all Information/data designated by the Institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the performance of the MoU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

6. DURATION OF MOU:

This MoU, unless extended by mutual, written consent of the institute, shall expire in **Five years** after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review of, the MOU shall be extended for another **Two** years by mutual consent.

7. CO-ORDINATORS :

Both Institutes will designate persons who will have responsibility for coordination of implementation of this agreement.

- Giving opportunities to attend seminars, Faculty Development Programs (FDP), conferences, workshops and short-term programs in the area of research through the expertise in the field of recent development, amendments in law, while extending invitations to each other's faculty to participate therein.
- Other areas as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

Implementation and Funding

The Parties hereby mutually agree that the cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MOU will be subject to the availability of funds to the Parties.

Dispute Settlement

The Parties hereby agree that they will consult together upon request of either party regarding any matter relating to the terms of this MOU and will endeavor jointly in a spirit of cooperation and mutual trust to resolve any difficulties or misunderstandings which may arise.

Amendment

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This deed of Memorandum of Understanding executed on the January 1st 2024 between;

1. **Samarthanam Trust** for the Disabled, a registered charitable organization represented by its Founder Chair and constituted Attorney Mr. Mahantesh G.K. having its Head Office at CA #39, 15th Cross, 16th Main, Sector-4 HSR Layout, Bengaluru-560102 (hereinafter called "**Service Agency**" which term shall, wherever the context permits, mean and include its legal heirs, legal representatives, executors, administrators and assigns) as one part

And

2. **Prof. Suyash Pradhan** represented by **Anand Vishwa Gurukul College of Law Thane** having its office at N.R. COLONY, Bengaluru-560019 (hereinafter called as "**Partner Agency**" which term shall mean, wherever the context permits, mean and include its legal heirs, legal representatives, executors, administrators and assigns) as the other part

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The terms and conditions of this MOU are as follows:

I. Purpose:

- A. The overall objective of this Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) is to create ample opportunities for youth/persons with disabilities in order to ensure their active participation and involvement in the programs of educational, and voluntary organizations without any kind of barriers with a strong feeling of effective and meaningful inclusion
- B. To facilitate the empowerment and socialization process of students for the productive citizens of tomorrow (future)
- C. This MOU between a wide range of Institutions, Agencies, Voluntary Organizations, NGOs, Universities, Centers, Institutes, as Partner Agencies and Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled as Service Agency will enable us to accomplish the above stated objectives through establishing strong linkages, networking and relationship
- D. The services and programs of NGOs (of partner agencies) stated in the MOU will be provided with free of cost to the students of the Institutions
- E. Both the parties have agreed to enter in to this MOU to provide services and programs stated in the Part-II of this MOU and not only limited to those services and programs. There is scope for inclusion or exclusion according to the need and situation through mutual consent:

II. PROGRAMS OR SERVICES:

Unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the parties, the Services governed by this agreement are the following:

1. Services by the Educational Institution/NGO/Agency/University(Partner Agency):

- (a) Mobilization of students with and without disabilities from deprived sections of the society for admission
- (b) Maximum rebate/concession in College tuition and admission fees
- (c) Barrier free and accessible library facilities with books and materials in most accessible formats
- (d) Volunteering support as per the need of the student
- (e) Scribe/writer/amenities support to undertake board, competitive or any sort of written tests or examinations
- (f) Sports activities with accessibility and barrier free environment and universal design ensured
- (g) Active participation of students of the institution as Volunteers (through NSS wing, NCC wing, guest lectures and motivation lectures by faculty/students etc.) in the activities of the service agency planned throughout the year
- (h) Infrastructure support by the institution for any activities planned by service agency



- (i) Promotion of inclusive sports, arts, cultural activities, recreation, leisure etc. for students
- (j) Facilitator role in internship, research programs, field work and block placements for students
- (j) Career Guidance and Counseling

2. Programs or Services of the Service Agency (Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled)

- Support in Tuition and other fee expenses for the students
- Free food and safe accommodation
- Assistive devices and technology
- Reading service for students and provision of advanced technology to compensate human reading service.
- Audio/Electronic/Braille/DAISY/Large print/pictorial books for students
- Coaching classes for competitive exams for students
- Career Guidance and Counseling
- Personality Development Sessions
- Coaching support in Sports and Cultural Programs

III. Duration:

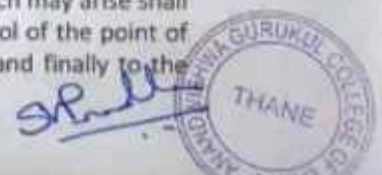
The MOU comes into effect from January 1st 2024 and ends on December 31st 2027. Subsequent MOU shall be made in order to continue the services with the mutual agreement and consent if both the parties are happy and satisfied with the services and relationship during the proposed MOU period.

IV. Termination:

Either of the parties are free to terminate the MOU in case they are not happy with the relationship or satisfied with the services provided by either of the agencies (Service) and (Partner) by giving one month notice stating the reasons for termination which shall help either of the agencies to improve their relationship further.

V. Point of Communication:

Both the parties shall nominate or appoint a designated person as point of communication person in order to ensure the smooth functioning and happenings of day to day activities. The point of communication persons shall appraise the head of the department or the head of the organization. The issues or problems which may arise shall be resolved at the level of point of communication, if beyond the control of the point of communication which shall be referred to head of the department and finally to the



head of the organization for final solutions. The contact details of point of communication persons are as follows:
