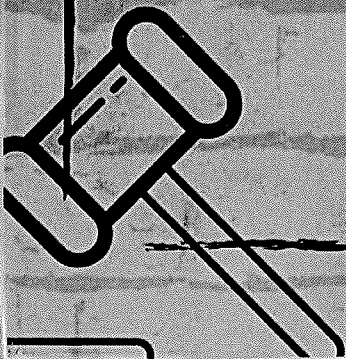

#### IV. Legal Writing, Research and Law Office Management

##### 4.1 Legal Writing - Article, Case Comment and Editing of a Law Journal.

###### → Introduction

- This module delves into the practical aspects of legal practice, encompassing legal writing, research, technology utilization and law office management.
- These skills are crucial for any aspiring lawyers, enabling them to effectively communicate, advocate and manage their practice.

###### → Legal Writing

- Legal Writing is a specialized form of writing used by lawyers, judges and other legal professionals to communicate legal information and arguments.
- It plays a crucial role in the legal profession, serving various purposes such as:

###### 1. Information-

- Clearly and accurately conveying legal information to clients, colleagues, and the court.

## 2. Persuading -

- Advocating for a particular legal position or outcome in court documents, legal memoranda or negotiations.

## 3. Analyzing -

- Examining legal issues, identifying relevant facts and laws, and applying them to specific situations.

## 4. Documenting -

- Creating legally sound documents like contracts, Wills and pleadings:

- The ability to communicate clearly, concisely and persuasively is paramount in the legal profession.

- Some practical tips to enhance the legal writing are as follows:

### 1. Clarity

- Writing should be easily understandable to both legal profession and lay person.

### 2. Conciseness

- Be direct and to the point.

### 3. Structure

- Organize your writing logically, using headings, subheading and numbered lists to improve readability.

4. Persuasiveness

- Draft strong arguments supported by evidence and Legal Authority. Anticipate and address Counterarguments.

5. Proof Reading

- Meticulously proof read your work to eliminate errors in grammar, punctuation and spelling.

→ Characteristics of effective Legal Writing

Effective legal Writing is characterized by several key qualities :-

1. Clarity and Precision

- Precise language  
Use specific and unambiguous terms to avoid misinterpretation.
- Concise Sentence  
Avoid unnecessary words and phrases to ensure clarity.
- Logical Organization  
Presenting information in a structured and easy to follow manner.
- Active Voice  
Use active voice rather than passive voice to make sentences more direct and clear.

## 2. Accuracy

### - Thorough Research

Support arguments with relevant statutes, case laws and regulations

### - Proper Citation

Using an accurate citation, ensures credibility

### - Proof Reading

Proof Reading is necessary to eliminate errors.

## 3. Persuasiveness

### - Objective Analysis

Present a balanced analysis of the legal issue, acknowledging strengths and weaknesses of the argument

## 4. Formality and Tone

### - Formal Language

Avoid slang and contractions.

### - Tone

Avoid emotional language or personal opinions

### - Respectful Language

Use respectful language when referring to the Court, opposing counsel and parties involved.

## → Article and Case Comment

- An Article or case comment is a scholarly piece of writing that analyzes and critiques a legal topic, recent legislation or a court decision.
- It is typically authored by legal scholars, law students or practising attorneys.
- They may also offer commentary on the implications of the decision, its impact on the legal landscape and potential future developments in the area of law.
- They can provide insight, guidance or criticism to legal professionals, policymakers, and the general public.
- Articles and Case Comments can be found in legal journals, newspapers and other legal publications.
- They are usually structured following the key elements of a court decision, such as the facts of the case, the legal issues presented, the court's analysis and reasoning, and the court's holding or decision.
- In addition, case comments often provide a detailed analysis of the court's reasoning and may also offer alternative interpretations or critiques of the decision.

## → Structure of a Case Comment.

The body of a case comment or article must comprise the following appendages:

1. Introduction
2. Background
3. Analysis
4. Conclusion
5. Using Foot-notes in a Case Comment

## → Case Comment.

### • Case :-

S. Gopal Reddy v/s State of Andhra Pradesh  
AIR 1996 SC 2185.

### \* Introduction

- The case S. Gopal Reddy v/s State of Andhra Pradesh was heard by the Supreme Court of India on July 11, 1996.
- The case involved the conviction of S. Gopal Reddy for dowry-related offences, and the Court ruled in his favor (convict's), setting aside his conviction and sentence.

## \* Facts of the Case.

- The appellant, M.S. Gopal Reddy, was an IPS officer who was accused of demanding dowry from the Bride's family during the marriage negotiations.
- The appellants' elder brother, G. Narayan Reddy, demanded dowry including a house, jewels, cash, clothes and a car.
- The accused insisted that the dowry be paid before the marriage and threatened to cancel it if the demand was not met.
- The appellant was accused of writing a letter to Nani asking her to cancel the marriage or fulfill the demands.
- The appellant and his brother were tried for offenses under Section 420 of IPC (Now, U/S. 318 of BNS), Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.
- The Trial Court convicted both and sentenced them to Rigorous imprisonment and liable to pay a fine.
- The Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge set aside the conviction and sentence for the offence under section 420 of IPC, but confirmed the conviction and sentence for the offense under Section 4 of the Act.
- The accused appealed to the High Court, but was unsuccessful.
- An appeal by Special Leave Petition was filed by the appellant, against the order of the

High Court of Andhra Pradesh dated 16.10.1990.

### \* Issue

Whether the demand of dowry made during the negotiations for marriage amounts to an offence under Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961?

### \* Arguments

- The Appellant's Counsel argued that the evidence against him was insufficient to establish his guilt beyond reasonable doubt.
- The Counsel pointed to the following issues:
  - The appellant denied writing letters that were used as evidence against him.
  - There was no corroboration of the complainant's evidence.
  - The prosecution failed to examine key witnesses.
  - The complainant may have exaggerated the case.
  - The trial Court, appellate Court and revisional Court relied on letters that the appellant denied writing and the Courts allowed emotionals to influence their judgment instead of using legally admissible evidence.



## \* Judgment.

- The Supreme Court ruled in favor of the appellant, setting aside his conviction and sentence.
- The Court recognized that, the evidence on the record does not establish beyond a reasonable doubt that any demand of dowry within the meaning of Section 2 read with Section 4 of the Act was made by the appellant.
- The Court further held that convictions cannot be based on assumptions; without the offence being proved beyond a reasonable doubt.
- This appeal, thus, succeeds and is allowed.

## \* Conclusion

- The case of S. Gopal Reddy v/s State of Andhra Pradesh involved an appellant who was charged for the offence of Dowry death.
- The Trial Court acquitted him, but the High Court reversed the order and sentenced the appellant to life in prison.
- However, the Supreme Court ruled that the evidence did not establish the appellant's guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
- The conviction and sentence of the appellant is hereby set aside.

## \* My Comment on the Case

- This case involved the interpretation of the term 'Dowry', under the Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.
- The Courts should interpret the provisions of the Act in light of the statute's intended purpose.
- The Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 is a piece of social legislation aimed at curbing the social evil of dowry and that it makes punishable not only the actual receiving of dowry but also the demand for dowry as well as giving of dowry.
- Section 304 B(2) and Section 498 A are the provisions of IPC available to the victim.
- Also while dealing with such matters, and concluding the judgment the trial courts must consider the admissibility of expert evidence and a great caution should be taken, corroborated by other evidence.
- The Act prohibits the demand of dowry as a consideration for marriage, but not the giving of gifts. Giving traditional gifts to the bride or bridegroom as a token of love and affection is valid under the Act.
- But, it is always better to register the gift given during the marriage. A list can be made and can be sworn as an affidavit and can be registered with the Protection officer under the act to prevent and curb any chaos later.

## → Editing of a Law Journal

### \* Law Journal

- A Law Journal, also known as a Law Review, is a scholarly publication that focuses on legal topics
- Law journals are a source of research and provide a scholarly analysis of legal concepts
- Some Law Journals in India includes the following :-
  1. Journal of the Indian Law Institute (1958)
  2. National Law School of India Review
  3. NLS Business Law Review
  4. Journal of National Law University Delhi
  5. Indian Journal of Law and Legal Research
  6. India Law Journal.

### \* Editing of Law Journal

- Editing of Law Journal involves reviewing and refining scholarly articles submitted for publication to ensure they meet the Journal's standards of quality, accuracy and style.
- Mastering the 7 C's — i.e. Clarity, Consistency, Correctness, Conciseness, Coherent, Concrete, Complete and Courteous, can significantly evaluate the quality of your writing and makes it more effective and enjoyable for the readers.

- Below mentioned are the factors which need to be considered by editors, when editing a Law Journal :-

### 1. Structure

- The manuscript should have a clear structure, with the introductory section logically dividing the article into its parts.

### 2. Content

- The author's arguments and contentions should make legal and logical sense.
- The editors should evaluate the author's use of statements about laws, historical events and other relevant information.

### 3. Clarity

- The article should be written in a concise and precise manner.

### 4. Consistency

- The Article should be consistent throughout.

### 5. Ambiguity

- The article should be free of ambiguity.

### 6. Citations

- Citations should be accurate and in the correct location.

## 7. Formatting

- The Article should be formatted according to the journal's guidelines.

## 8. Unbiased Consideration

- Considering all manuscripts without regard to the author's personal characteristics.

## 9. Prompt processing

- Processing manuscripts in a timely manner.

## 10. Proofreading

- Final review to find out any remaining errors in grammar, spelling and punctuation.

- Some other things to consider when editing Law Journal includes the following :-

### 1. Author guides

- Many journals have author guides that provide instructions on how to write and format articles.

### 2. Respecting intellectual independence

- Editors should respect the intellectual independence of authors.

### 3. Delegating responsibility

- Editors should delegate editorial responsibility for manuscripts they have authored to another qualified person.

- \* Alternatives for Editors through technology -
- Law Journal Editors may use tools like PerfectIt to check for spelling, capitalization, hyphenation, italicization and common typos.
  - They may also use an editing-for-conciseness manual to help identify wordy sentences.

\* Editors also need to be aware of ethical issues that may arise, such as :-

- Plagiarism
- Allegations about author contributions
- Duplicate submission or Publication
- Violations of research standards
- Manipulations of the peer review process
- Allegations of inappropriate duplication or alteration of images.

### → Conclusion.

- Legal Writings such as Articles, Case Comments and Law Journal Editing, helps the law aspirants to improve their writing and drafting skills.
- Early proficiency in these skills gives students a competitive edge in internships and their subsequent legal careers.
- Moreover, it provides insights of judicial decisions to the layman and helps them to understand the Law.
- It provides an in-depth analysis of the key legal issues and potential future developments in Law.

## 4.2 Research for Public Interest Litigation.

### → Introduction

- The expression 'Public Interest Litigation' has been borrowed from American Jurisprudence, where it was designed to provide legal representation to previously unrepresented groups like the poor, the racial minorities, unorganized consumers, citizens who were passionate about the environmental issues, etc.

### → Meaning.

#### \* Research.

- Research is a systematic study of materials and sources to establish facts and reach new conclusions.
- It involves collecting data, documenting information and analyzing and interpreting that data.
- It is the process of discovering new knowledge or using existing knowledge in a new way to create new concepts, methodologies, and understandings.

#### \* Public Interest Litigation

- Public Interest Litigation means a litigation filed in a Court of law, in the benefit or

- for the protection of "Public Interest", such as Pollution, Terrorism, Environmental issues, Safety, Constructional hazards, etc.
- Any matter where the interest of Public at large is affected can be redressed by filing a Public Interest litigation in Court of Law.
  - It is a litigation conducted for the benefit of public or for removal of some public grievance.
  - It is also initiated in a Court of Law for enforcement of Public rights in which the public at large or community as a whole has an interest.

### → Defination.

According to Black's Law Dictionary -

Public Interest is defined as follows:

"Public Interest - something in which the public, the community at large, has some pecuniary interest, or some interest by which their legal rights or liabilities are affected."

According to Oxford English Dictionary -

The word litigation means:

"A legal action including proceeding in a Court of Law with the purpose of enforcing a right or seeking a remedy."



## → Research for Public Interest Litigation

- Public Interest Litigation is a powerful tool for addressing social injustice and promoting the public good.
- Effective research is crucial for building a strong PIL case.
- The research process typically involves the following:
  1. Identifying the issue
    - Clearly define the social problem and identify the affected group or community.
  2. Legal Research
    - Conduct thorough research to identify relevant laws, statutes, regulations and case precedents that support your case.
  3. Factual Investigation
    - Gather evidence to support your claims, including affidavits, documents and expert opinions.
  4. Formulating Arguments
    - Develop clear and persuasive legal arguments based on your research and evidence.
  5. Identifying Respondents
    - Identify the appropriate government authorities or private entities that are responsible for the issue.

## → Sources and Methods for conducting Public Interest Litigation Research.

1. Legal Databases
2. Government Reports and Publications
3. NGOs and Research Organizations
4. Field Visits and Interviews.
5. Right to information (RTI) Act.

## → Essentials for the existence of PIL

- There are four necessary conditions, for the Public Interest Litigation to come into existence:
  1. There must be a legal wrong caused to a person or community.
  2. The wronged person or group must be unable to approach the court for relief due to poverty, helplessness or other reasons.
  3. The PIL must be initiated to seek redress for a public grievance, not for personal gain or malicious motives.
  4. PIL must be filed by a public-spirited person or an association of persons acting on behalf of those injured. The court can also take action on a letter if it is addressed by the aggrieved person, if the case is appropriate and is filed before the appropriate court.

## → Constitutional Provisions

The Constitution of India provides with provisions under Sects Article 32 and Article 226 for upholding and guaranting the doctrine of PIL

### 1. Article 32 (Supreme Court)

- Under Article 32 of the Constitution, the aggrieved person can approach the Supreme Court of India for the violation of right and removal of public grievance.
- It allows the Court to issue writs, including writs of Habeas Corpus, Mandamus, Prohibition, Certiorari and Quo Warranto, for the protection of the Fundamental and Legal Rights.

### 2. Article 226

- This Article provides the High Courts with the power to issue writs for the enforcement of fundamental rights within their respective jurisdictions.
- This includes the authority to entertain PIL petitions and issue directions for the protection of public interest.

### 3. Fundamental Rights

- Various Fundamental Rights enshrined in Part III of the Constitution of India, such as the right to equality (Article 14), right to life and personal liberty (Article 21), right

against exploitation (Article 23), and right to Constitutional remedies (Article 32), serve as the basis for PIL petitions.

#### 4. Directive Principles of State Policy

- While not enforceable by courts, the Directive Principles of State Policy, (Part IV) of the Constitution of India, provides guidelines for state policy-making.
- PILs often invoke these principles to advocate for social justice, environmental protection, and other public interest objectives.

#### → Significance of PIL

- The aim of PIL is to give to the common people access to the courts to obtain legal redress.
- PIL is an important instrument of social change and for maintaining the Rule of Law and accelerating the balance between law and justice.
- It is an important tool to make human rights reach those who have been denied rights and to make justice accessible to the poor and the marginalized.
- Any citizen or organization can file petitions on behalf of those who do not have means to do so.

- It helps in judicial monitoring of state institutions like prisons, asylums, protective homes, etc.
- It is an efficient tool for implementing the concept of Judicial review.
- Enhanced public participation in judicial review of administrative action is assured by the inception of PILs.

### → Objective Features of PIL in India.

• Here are some objective features of Public Interest Litigation (PIL) in India :-

#### 1. Ensuring Justice

- PILs are used to ensure justice to all and promote the welfare of the people.

#### 2. Protecting group interests

- PILs is generally used to safeguard group interests rather than individual interests.

#### 3. Promoting the Rule of Law

- PIL aims to vindicate the Rule of Law.

#### 4. Clarifying Laws

- PILs help in clarifying the societal laws and widen the scope of Law through interpretation done by the Court.

### 5. Holding Public Accountable

- PILs help to hold public accountable and ensure that they make appropriate and required decisions.

### 6. Ensuring Transparency

- PILs ensure transparency in government departments.

### 7. Making Judicial process more democratic

- PIL is a part of Judicial Activism which makes the judicial process more democratic.

### 8. Relaxation of Locus Standi

- Traditional rule of "standing in the court", (only the aggrieved party can approach the court) is relaxed, allowing anyone with a genuine concern to file a PIL.

## → Genesis and Evolution of PIL in India

- The seeds of the concept of Public Interest litigation were initially sown in India by Justice Krishna Iyer, in 1976 in Mumbai Kamagar Sabha v/s Abdul Hai.

- The first reported case of PIL was Hussainara Khatoon v/s State of Bihar (1979) that focused on the inhuman conditions of prisons and under trial prisoners that

led to the release of more than 40,000 under trial prisoners.

Right to speedy justice emerged as a basic fundamental right which had been denied to these prisoners. The same set pattern was adopted in subsequent cases.

- A new era of the PIL movement was heralded by Justice P.N. Bhagwati in the case of S.P. Gupta v/s Union of India. By this judgement PIL became a potent weapon for the enforcement of "public duties".
- The Supreme Court in Indian Bank's Association, Bombay & Ors. v/s M/s Devkala Consultancy Service and Ors. held that a private interest case can also be treated as public interest case.
- M.C. Mehta took lots of efforts to ensure that the concept of PILs was clearly enunciated.

### → Factors Responsible for the growth of PIL in India.

1. The Character of the Indian Constitution.
2. The most progressive social legislations of India including environment protection, Minimum wages, bonded labour, etc.

3. The liberal interpretation of locus standi
4. The wide expansion of the scope of Article 21 - 'Right to life', including, right to free legal aid, right to live with dignity, right to education, right to work, freedom from torture, ban fetters and hand cuffing in prisons, etc.
5. Judicial innovations to help the poor and marginalised.
6. Judicial assistance provided by the Courts to the petitioner who are voluminous or socially and economically weak.

→ Who can file a PIL.

Any citizen can file a public case by filing a Petition:

- Under Article 32 of the Indian Constitution in the Supreme Court.
- Under Article 226 of the Indian Constitution, in the High Court.
- Under Section 133 of the Criminal Procedure Code, in the Court of Magistrate.

However, the Court must be satisfied that the writ petition fulfils some basic needs for PIL as follows:

- The letter must be addressed by the aggrieved person.
- Public spirited individual and a social action group for the enforcement of legal or Constitutional rights to any person who are not able to approach the Court for redress.

### → Against Whom a PIL can be filed.

- A Public Interest Litigation can be filed against a State / Central Government, Municipal Authorities, and not any private party.
- The term 'State', under Article 12 of the Indian Constitution includes the Government, Parliament of India, the legislature of each of the states and all local or other authorities within the territory of India.

### → Locus standi.

- Locus standi is a Latin term that refers to the legal right to bring a law suit or legal action.
- In Public Interest Litigation, the traditional rules of locus standi have been liberalized to allow a person to file a PIL if they have a genuine interest in the Public issues.
- It is a right to stand in the Court, whose rights are infringed, to seek redressal.
- The PIL is an exception to this rule.

## → Case law (Hussainara Khatoon case)

### \* Hussainara Khatoon v/s State of Bihar

- This is a landmark case, in which the fundamental right to a speedy trial emerged as an essential aspect of Justice under Article 21 of the Indian Constitution.
- The case established that undue delays in the trial process were unconstitutional and that timely justice is essential for maintaining the Rule of law.

### \* Case Reference in PIL

- It is a first reported case of PIL.
- The case highlighted the plight of undertrial prisoners and led to significant prison reforms.
- This case demonstrated the power of PIL in addressing systematic issues and protecting the rights of marginalized groups.

### \* Case's Recommendations for PIL

1. Focus on strong evidence and legal arguments
2. Collaborate with NGOs and experts for support
3. Utilize media and public awareness to strengthen the case.
4. Be persistent and prepared for a long legal battle.

## → Writs.

- Writs are the formal written orders given by the Administrative and Judicial authorities to enforce the right to constitutional remedies in instances of violation of Fundamental Rights.
- The Supreme Court can issue writ under Article 32 and the High Court can issue a writ under Article 226 of the Constitution.

## \* Types of Writs.

- There are five types of Writs, which are as below mentioned :-

1. Habeas Corpus.
2. Mandamus.
3. Certiorari.
4. Prohibition.
5. Quo-Warranto.

- They serve distinct purposes.

### 1. Habeas Corpus

- The meaning of the word is 'to have the body'.
- The purpose of this Writ is to remove a person from unlawful detention or custody.

## 2. Mandamus.

- The literal meaning of Mandamus is 'We Command'.
- The purpose of this Writ is to direct to a public official, ordering to perform the official duties, when failed to perform or refused to do so.
- It can be used against any public figure, corporation, a lower Court and a tribunal.

## 3. Certiorari.

- It literally means, 'to be certified', or 'to be informed'.
- The Writ can be issued when the Court finds the decision of the lower Court beyond its authority, the Court can quash the verdict of the inferior Court.
- It is used as Curative Writ petition.

## 4. Prohibition.

- The literal meaning of Prohibition is 'to forbid'.
- This Writ aims to stop the judicial, quasi-judicial authorities along with Tribunals from exceeding their authority.
- It directs the inactivity to prevent the excessive application of one's jurisdiction.

## 5. Quo Warranto

- It literally means 'by what Authority?'
- The Court issues this writ to ask the public official to table his authority of holding that office, and the Court can suspend his authority.
- The Court investigates the person's claim to a public office and its legality.
- For the Redressal of the Constitutional Remedy the appropriate Writ must be chosen based on the nature of the Violation.

## → Misuse of Public Interest Litigation.

- Public Interest Litigation is a legal process that can be misused for personal or political gain, instead of for the public good.
- Some examples of misuse include the following :-
  1. Frivolous cases
    - Individuals or organizations may file cases that are not based on a significant public issue, wasting the Court's time.
  2. Harassment
    - PILs can be used to harass opponents.

### 3. Personal grievances.

- Individuals may use PILs to push their own personal grievances, instead of championing public causes.

### 4. Delaying Development

- PILs can be used to delay developmental activities.

### 5. Judicial overreach

- The process of resolving issues through PILs can sometimes lead to judicial overreach, where the courts are perceived to be encroaching upon the domain of other branches of government.

### 6. Lack of enforcement

- Even when courts issue directives, there may be a lack of enforcement mechanisms.

→ Has Public Interest Litigation proved to be a Boon

- Yes, public interest litigation has been a boon in solving public grievances :-

1. It provides access to justice.
2. It brought about a social change
3. It protects rights
4. It facilitates Judicial Review.

5. It protects environment
6. It addresses labor rights.
7. It curbs government power.

- PILs are meant to establish a good structure of governance that protects the interests of everyone in society.

### → Conclusion.

- Public Interest litigation has produced astonishing results which were unthinkable three decades ago.
- The greatest contribution of PIL has been to enhance the accountability of the governments towards the human rights of the poor.
- The PIL develops a new jurisprudence of the accountability of the state for constitutional and legal violations adversely affecting the interests of the weaker elements in the community.
- Besides, the frivolous PILs with vested interests must be discouraged to keep its workload manageable.

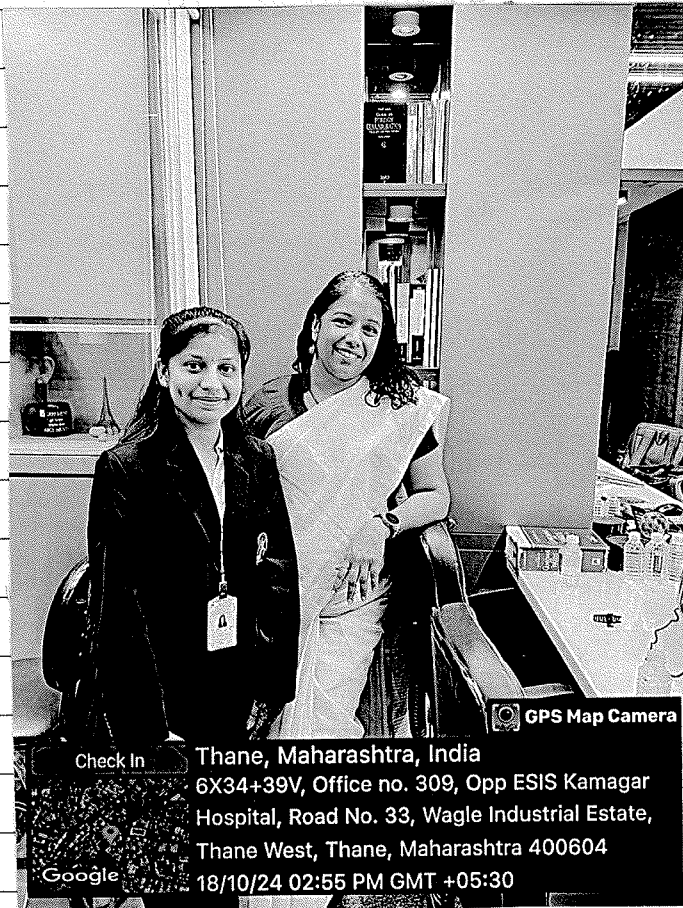




## Porsche crash case: Can the juvenile be tried as an adult?

The 17-year-old boy who killed two software engineers with his speeding Porsche in Pune's Kalyani Nagar early on Sunday was sent to an observation home following an order by the Juvenile Justice Board (JJB).

Earlier, the JJB had granted the minor bail within hours of his arrest. The JJB had also rejected the police's request for his trial as an adult. The bail conditions included writing a 300-word essay on accidents, painting traffic awareness boards, working with a traffic constable, and attending counselling sessions. This sparked outrage among the public, with even Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis calling it "shocking and surprising".

"We feel JJB's order ended up raising many questions. The board took a lenient view of the matter. The order needs to be reviewed," he added.

Following the outcry, the JJB on Wednesday issued a notice to the minor to appear before it. Later in the day, it remanded him to the observation home until June 7. However, the question of whether he will be tried as an adult still remains.

According to advocate Prashant Patil, who represented the minor at

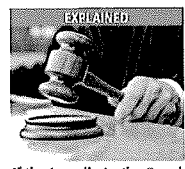
the JJB hearing, the process of deciding whether a minor should be treated as an adult can take at least two months as reports from psychiatrists and counsellors, among others, are called for, and then the JJB gives its decision.

**What does the law say?**

According to Section 15 of the Juvenile Justice Act, to decide whether the minor can be tried as an adult, the JJB needs to conduct a preliminary assessment of the minor's mental and physical capacity to commit an offence, his ability to understand the consequences of the offence, and the circumstances in which he allegedly committed the offence.

"This amendment to the Juvenile Justice Act came after the 2012 Nirbhaya case, which stated that children between the ages of 16-18 can face trial as adults if they are accused of a heinous crime. 'Heinous crime' is defined under the law as 'any offence punishable with more than seven years imprisonment.' These include murder, rape, robbery, acid attacks, wage war against the government, drug trafficking, and human trafficking, among others.

If the JJB decides to try the minor

new law i.e., Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), but there is a provision in BNS which provides 10 years' imprisonment if the person causing it does not inform the concerned authorities. Keeping this in mind, it is to be seen whether acts of such gravity should be dealt with under rash and negligent driving or culpable homicide."

Citing examples, Sharma said, "In the Alistair Pereira case, the Supreme Court held that rash or negligent driving with the knowledge of the dangerous character and the likely effect of the act, resulting in death, may fall in the category of culpable homicide not amounting to murder. The police in that case had decided to make a case under Section 304 and not Section 301A."

"The JJB, in a similar case of drinking and driving resulting in death by a 16-year-old boy, i.e., Shilpa Mittal v NCT of Delhi, had ordered the trial of the minor as an adult, but the major became right now in the Juvenile Law, which was pointed out, was the definition of heinous crime which says that the minimum punishment shall be of seven years for classification as a heinous offence for trying the minor as an adult. The Supreme Court in the same case held that until there is an

amendment in legislation, crimes where no minimum punishment is given but the maximum punishment is more than seven years, shall be treated as serious offences and not heinous offences," he added.

"Even the introduction of the new criminal law BNS does not change the scenario since it also does not prescribe any minimum punishment for cases where the act is done with the knowledge of causing death. So there is an urgent need for an amendment in the provision so that it conforms and is consistent with the gravity of such acts," Sharma further said.

The Pune Porsche Crash Case, the SC lawyer said, is a glaring example of the lacuna in the law. "The minor driver was drunk, rash, and negligent and still the JJB left him scot-free with reprimands of a non-serious nature. The JJB was duty-bound to follow the letter of the law and the law of the land. But this clearly reflects that this law needs change. The JJB should have sent the minor to a correctional home while awaiting whether a heinous offence had been committed by the minor or not, and only after that should bail have been considered by either the JJB," he added.

## Damages recovery to be handled like civil issue, says Meerut ADM

MEERUT, JANUARY 6

MEERUT ADDITIONAL District Magistrate Ajay Kumar Tiwari has said that the process of recovering money from those who destroyed public property will be handled like any other civil issue.

Last week, the district administration demanded close to Rs 25,000 each from more than 140 people for the damage in the city during violence amid the protests against the new citizenship law on December 20, which left five people dead. This is the first such exercise undertaken by the government.

"The process (of recovery) has just been initiated. If a police station is prima facie satisfied that the person to show cause within seven days," Tiwari said.

"Seven days is allowed but if a

person requests, a reasonable extension will be given," he added.

Legally, the show-cause notices have to be served in person, wherever possible. Additionally, it can be served through next of kin or, if all other means fail, can be served through placing an advertisement in a newspaper.

As of Friday, no response to the show causes issued had been received by the ADM's office.

"As per the Civil Procedure Code, a balance of probability will be kept in mind like in all civil cases. The accused is free to bring a lawyer and witnesses who can make a case that he was not involved in destruction of public property," he said. The ADM will be the adjudicating authority and parties can challenge the order subsequently in court.

"The loss of property for the administration is the same even if it is worth Re 1 or Rs 1 lakh. This is the idea behind holding those who caused damage responsible.

How much each guilty individual pays depends on many other factors," Tiwari said.

The proportion of damage may be recovered from an individual will be determined in the next step after a detailed hearing, he said.

"The punitive liability is important because the administration is recovering damages for the tax payer and not for itself. The damage is borne by the tax payer if it is not recovered by the actual perpetrators," Tiwari said.

According to preliminary estimate prepared by the PWD, Nagar Nigam, Meerut Development Authority and Road Transport Office for police vehicles that were damaged, the total cost of damaged property is pegged at Rs 40.87 lakh.

"As of now, it is a rough estimate. I have asked for an elaborate report. For example, if railings or dividers have been damaged, then length, description and cost along with photographs will be collected to arrive at the figure," he said.

## SC tells HCs to set up panels to monitor POCSO Act trials

Supreme Court shocked by high rate of pendency of child sexual assault cases

Shocked by the high rate of pendency of child sexual assault cases, the Supreme Court directed High Courts to set up panels of its judges to regulate and monitor trials under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act.

The Supreme Court, which had ordered a review of the backlog under POCSO, found that States such as Uttar Pradesh have over 30,000 cases pending despite the child protection law coming into existence as early as 2012.

Many States have not yet even set up special courts to try POCSO cases as mandated by the law.

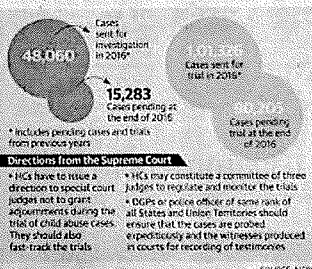
**Bad implementation**

In February, a three-judge Bench led by Chief Justice of India Dipak Mishra found the implementation of POCSO a shambles and decided to review the issue. The Bench was hearing the case of rape of an eight-month-old child in the National Capital.

The PIL petition filed by **Alakh Alok Srivastava** said child rapists should be awarded the death penalty.

**Justice delayed**

Only 10% of cases filed under the POCSO Act, which deals with sexual abuse of minors, were recorded in police investigation at the end of 2019, while 89% were pending trials

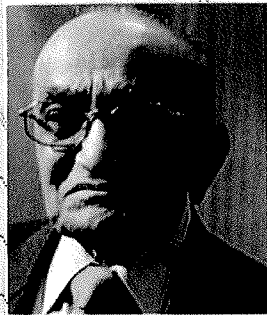


Though the government was initially against the death penalty in child rape cases, saying "death penalty is not an answer for every child," the rape of an eight-year-old in Kathua proved to be the last straw and the government recently promulgated an ordinance allowing courts to pronounce death penalty to those found guilty of raping children up to 12 years of age.

**Speedy Justice**

Additional Solicitor General Pinky Anand, for the government, informed the court about the ordinance. She submitted that it warrants investigation to be completed in two months and courts to dispose of appeals in six months, ensuring speedy justice to victims. But the court said the POCSO statistics showed that children and victims in many States were still waiting in the corridors of courts for justice.

The Bench, also comprising Justices A.M. Khanwilkar and D.Y. Chandrachud, issued a series of directions which supplement the ordinance. These include: the State police chiefs should constitute special task forces to investigate cases. High Courts should ensure that they are tried and disposed of by the designated Special Courts under the Act; POCSO judges will give no adjournments and make every effort to fast-track trial, with expenses should be produced in court on the day of the hearing and high court should make every effort to provide a child-friendly atmosphere in tune with the spirit of the Act.
